Strategisch Partnering in de bouw (Purchasing excellence in the construction sector) 2007-present

Introduction

Based on the positive results achieved during Purchasing Excellence 1 in the profit sector and not-for-profit sector, the question arose to translate this program to the Dutch construction sector ('SPIN'). As the name shows, this program is executed in Dutch. In order to do this the framework model (MSU model) had to be adjusted for the specifics of the (Dutch) construction sector.

Approach

With joint efforts of delegates from all types of construction organizations, purchasing & supply chain professors and the project team, the 'MSU Bouw' model has been developed based on the MSU and MSU+ model. Similar to Purchasing Excellence for not-for-profit audits will be held at organizations in the construction sector to create zero-base measurements. Auditors are being trained to do these audits. Based on these measurement improvement programs will be set up and implemented. The results of the zero base measurement and improvement programs will be described and communicated.

Results

The adjusted MSU model is almost completed. The audits will be done in the first half of 2008. Results will be published via this website en via 'PSI Bouw', the innovation platform for the Dutch construction sector.
